## Bin contents survey sheet

Review what is going into your general waste bin and save your business money.

The most common materials found in general waste bins are:

Type of material	Common example	
Aluminium	Aluminium drink cans	
Cardboard	Cartons and packaging	
Electronic waste	Computer, office equipment and all electrical items	
Food waste	Food scraps, discontinued or out of date food stock	
Garden organics	Plant clippings and leaves	
Glass	Bottles and jars	
Paper	Office paper and wrapping	
Plastic film	Plastic pallet wrap and plastic bags	
Plastic rigid	Plastic pails, bottles and crates, plastic bottles and takeaway food containers	
Steel	Steel cans and metal strapping	
Wood	Timber pallets and other wood products	

## All the material categories listed here could be recycled.

Putting these materials in the appropriate recycling bin can significantly reduce the cost of the collection of general waste.

Using these material categories identify from your general waste bins the volume of each that should go in a recycling bin.


