AMENDMENT No. 3 TO INTEGRATED FORESTRY OPERATIONS APPROVAL FOR THE BRIGALOW NANDEWAR REGION

SCHEDULE 1 - AMENDMENTS TO THE INTEGRATED FORESTRY OPERATIONS APPROVAL FOR BRIGALOW-NANDEWAR REGION

[1] Clause 5(2)(a) and note to clause 5(2)(a)

Omit clause 5(2)(a) and the note below it and insert the following paragraph and note instead:

(a) logging operations for the purpose of producing logs (of any quality and kind) from white cypress trees (being trees of the species *Callitris glaucophylla*), but no more than 716,492 m³ of logs over the 17 year period commencing 1 January 2009, and no more than 57,000 m³ of logs (that is, 41, 000 m³ + (40% x 41, 000 m³)) in any one financial year,

Note: The figure of 41,000m³ in the above paragraph reflects the annual allocation of white cypress logs under long-term Wood Supply Agreements entered into in 2006. The figure of 11, 992 m3 represents the quantity of wood forfeited under the Agreements up to 30 June 2008 (that is, the quantity of wood that, when this approval was granted, was no longer available under the terms of those Agreements, being that part of the accumulated undercut that cannot be carried forward into subsequent years).
