**AMENDMENT No. 3 TO INTEGRATED FORESTRY OPERATIONS APPROVAL  
FOR THE BRIGALOW NANDEWAR REGION**

**SCHEDULE 1 - AMENDMENTS TO THE INTEGRATED FORESTRY OPERATIONS  
APPROVAL FOR  
BRIGALOW-NANDEWAR REGION**

**[1] Clause 5(2)(a) and note to clause 5(2)(a)**

Omit clause 5(2)(a) and the note below it and insert the following paragraph and note instead:

- (a) logging operations for the purpose of producing logs (of any quality and kind) from white cypress trees (being trees of the species *Callitris glaucophylla*), but no more than 716,492 m<sup>3</sup> of logs over the 17 year period commencing 1 January 2009, and no more than 57,000 m<sup>3</sup> of logs (that is, 41, 000 m<sup>3</sup> + (40% x 41, 000 m<sup>3</sup>)) in any one financial year,

*Note: The figure of 41,000m<sup>3</sup> in the above paragraph reflects the annual allocation of white cypress logs under long-term Wood Supply Agreements entered into in 2006. The figure of 11, 992 m<sup>3</sup> represents the quantity of wood forfeited under the Agreements up to 30 June 2008 (that is, the quantity of wood that, when this approval was granted, was no longer available under the terms of those Agreements, being that part of the accumulated undercut that cannot be carried forward into subsequent years).*
