 - Expand to include horticultural activities which contribute a significant amount of nutrients to the environment. A focus on horticultural activities through the load based licensing scheme would have a significant impact on the reduction of nutrients to waterways. Supporting documentation "Lower Hawkesbury Nepean River Nutrient Management Strategy" Section 2.3.3 first dot point "Intensive horticulture generally recognised as a significant contributor to diffuse source nutrient pollution in the Hawkesbury-Nepean catchment on a per hectare basis. This activity accounts for an estimated 14% and 24% of the diffuse load of phosphorous and nitrogen respectively."
