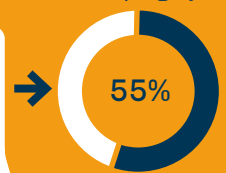


5 regional illegal dumping squads and programs established in partnership with councils, have investigated **85,547** illegal dumping incidents

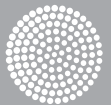
Environmental protection
