Transporting your materials safely

Transporting your materials safely to a Chemical CleanOut event is important. Here are some top tips for safe storage and transportation:

- Tape the terminals of batteries. If handling leaking or corroded batteries, wear gloves and place batteries in a sealed plastic bag.
- Ensure containers are clearly labelled and well-sealed.
 If you do not know the contents, label the container
 'UNKNOWN CHEMICAL'.
- Wherever possible keep all chemicals in their original containers.
- Never mix chemicals as this may produce dangerous reactions.
- Liquid can leak during transportation. Wrap old or damaged containers in newspaper, place in a sturdy plastic bag and then in a plastic container or tray.
- Keep household chemicals away from passengers e.g. in the boot.
- Before attending, place all materials in the rear of your vehicle. On arrival, remain in your vehicle and our contractor will collect your items.
