To whom it my concern,

I am concerned the remake of the Coastal Integrated Forestry Operations Approvals will reduce protection for native forests. The remake proposes removing limits on logging intensity. This could allow clear felling of native forests, a clear threat to native ecosystems. The remake needs to limit logging intensity to sustainable levels. Logging to meet timber supply targets is not the way forward. We need to rethink these targets and limit logging intensity.

I am opposed to changes to the Coastal Integrated Forestry Operations Approvals that will allow more intensive logging, and demand targets that are unsustainable. Please take into account the impact on native ecosystems in the remake, without purely focusing on economic outcomes.
